The successful candidate will conduct an independent research programme complementary to the Department's research strategy which will be capable of attracting significant external research funding. You will organize and deliver high-quality teaching to pre-clinical medical and biomedical science students, provide supervision and research training for graduate students, and contribute to the examining and admissions processes as necessary.

You will have a higher degree in basic science and/or a medical qualification and will be able to demonstrate a research record of international standing witnessed by peer reviewed publications, as well as evidence of imaginative research plans and the potential to lead and manage new research initiatives. A record of success in securing research funding is desirable/essential.

You will be able to demonstrate the ability to teach high-achieving and challenging undergraduates and to supervise graduate students. A willingness undertake administration and pastoral responsibilities on behalf of both the College and the University is essential.
